

Teenage Pregnancy Liaison Midwife (TPLM) Pathway

<p>All pregnant teenagers aged 17 or under at conception will be booked and case-loaded by TPLM. Delivering a personalised plan of care with Continuity of Carer. TPLM will refer directly to Family Nurse Partnership (FNP).</p>		
<p>Pregnant teenagers aged 18 or 19 will be booked by their CMW and then referred to TPLM and FNP using Teenage Pregnancy referral form. TPLM will assess level of input required based on information provided. If further information discovered as pregnancy progresses TPLM will adjust input accordingly. TPLM will take into account enrollment with FNP and Community Midwife (CMW) engagement.</p>		
<p>ADDITIONAL SUPPORT – case-loaded by CMW team with advice as required from TPLM. CMW to liaise with FN if enrolled or Health Visitor (HV).</p>	<p>COMPLEX NEEDS – TPLM will provide telephone support and assist CMW to deliver a personalised plan of care.</p> <p>TPLM will liaise with CMW and FN, if enrolled, or HV and any other agencies involved/required.</p>	<p>ACUTE NEEDS – TPLM will visit and complete and provide a personalised plan of care.
